Cheryl was already struggling to make ends meet after recently losing her job and sense of purpose. Now she had lost her partner too. On top of all this, without an income she was also worried about losing her home. It was a very dark time for Cheryl.

Thankfully, the Salvos community were there to wrap their arms around her and support her through her grief and financial hardship.

Thanks to your generosity, we were able to support Cheryl with the funeral arrangements and costs.

Additionally, her Salvos Caseworker provided financial support and organised a place for her to call home. Cheryl was overwhelmed with relief. This was a huge turning point for her that changed everything.

Sarah has since completed a TAFE course and found a new job, whilst the kids have settled into their new home and new school.

Ray Meagher on why he supports the Salvos


Ray Meagher, best known as Alf Stewart from "Home and Away," has been a long-time supporter and ambassador for The Salvation Army.
