Following the morning service you are invited to share in morning tea. Please bring a pack of Hot Cross Buns to share.

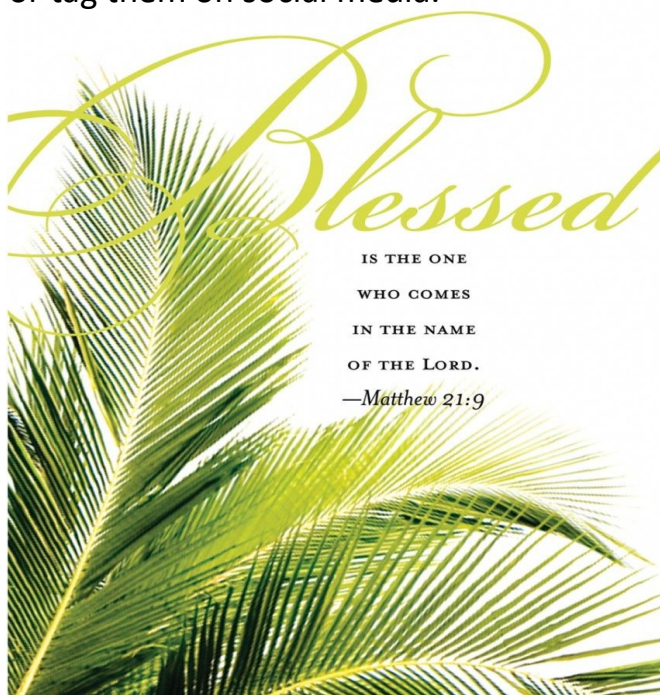
