



When he heard Jesus was walking down the road near where he was, Bartimaeus called out for Jesus to have mercy on him. He was told by the crowd to be quiet but that only made him call out louder. You see Bartimaeus had faith that an encounter with Jesus would be life changing. You can read what exactly happened in Mark 10:46-52.

Do you believe that Jesus can and will rescue you from your situation? Do you believe that an encounter with Jesus will transform your life? Maybe you think your circumstances stop Jesus from having anything to do with you. Perhaps you feel that you should be more presentable before coming to Jesus but that is not the truth and not how Jesus works. He meets each of us right where we are in the middle of our circumstances and in his loving and compassionate way he desires to bring about a transformation in us.
