Dispute worry with God's word. Engage in the now instead of the not yet.

I find it incredibly assuring to know that long before the time when society had the wonderful expertise of Psychologists to assist with personal wellbeing, God's word gave us helpful direction to be able to not only survive but flourish through times which are difficult.

Scripture: Matthew 6:30-33 (The Message)

'If God gives such attention to the appearance of wildflowers—most of which are never even seen—don't you think he'll attend to you, take pride in you, do his best for you? What I'm trying to do here is to get you to relax, to not be so preoccupied with getting, so you can respond to God's giving. People who don't know God and the way he works fuss over these things, but you know both God and how he works. Steep your life in God-reality, God-initiative, God-provisions. Don't worry about missing out. You'll find all your everyday human concerns will be met'

To be present in the now, instead of worrying about the future continues to be a challenge for many of us. God's word can be a 'light' to guide and direct us.

'When you go through the deep waters, I will be with you. When you go through rivers of difficulty, you will not drownbecause I love you' (Isaiah 43: 2 &4)
